Tulsa Dermatology Clinic Celebrates 40th Anniversary

In 1968, Tulsa medical physicians Dwane Minor, Kendrick Doran and Vincent Barranco joined their dermatology practices to create a highly specialized clinic. Today, after 40 years, Tulsa Dermatology Clinic, Inc. has grown to be the largest dermatology practice in the state.

The physician owned and operated clinic is located at 2121 East 21st Street in the same building purchased by the doctors in 1970, since renovated twice. The original location of Tulsa Dermatology Clinic was at 2227 East 21st.

The practice's current owners/physicians are: L.J. Gregg, M.D.; Don Seidel, M.D.; Mark Lehman, M.D.; George Monks, M.D.; and Kelli Lovelace, M.D. Christina Kendrick, M.D., will join the practice in December.

"We have always strived to set a high bar on quality care," said Dr. Gregg in explaining the clinic's longevity

in Tulsa. "All our physicians hold faculty appointments at the OU Health Sciences Center in Tulsa, and we are very proud the clinic has been awarded the OUHSC Aesculapian Award for outstanding clinical teaching."

The physicians at Tulsa Dermatology Clinic specialize in the diagnosis and treatment of all diseases of the skin, hair and nails, including most skin cancers. The primary focus is on general dermatology with doctors performing cosmetic procedures, laser, Botox, sclerotherapy for superficial blood vessels, injectable dermal fillers (Juvederm), microdermabrasion, and skin rejuvenation. The clinic offers ultraviolet light treatments and radiation therapy for skin cancer.

"All procedures at Tulsa Dermatology Clinic are performed or directly supervised by board certified M.D.'s," noted Dr. Gregg, "and doctors are assisted by a highly trained and skilled support staff."
